General Admission Information:

Applications must be submitted by Friday, February 1

- Transitional Kindergarten applicants must be four years of age on or before September 1, 2019. No exceptions will be made. Letters of acceptance for the 2019-2020 school year will be mailed by the middle of March.
- Kindergarten applicants must be five years of age on or before September 1, 2019. No exceptions will be made. Students applying for Kindergarten will be scheduled for an assessment during the month of February. Letters of acceptance for the 2019-2020 school year will be mailed by the middle of March.

- State Certificate of Birth (hospital certificates are not legal documents).
- Certificate for Baptism - if applicable.
- Immunization record.
